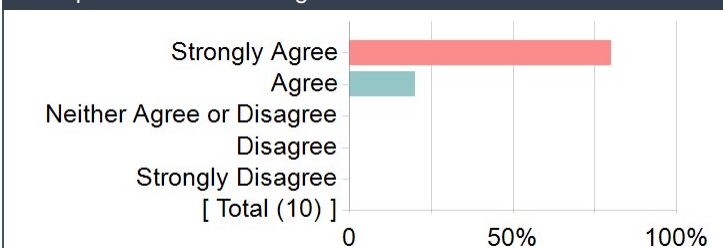

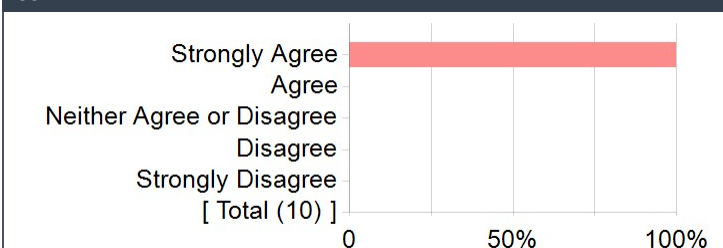

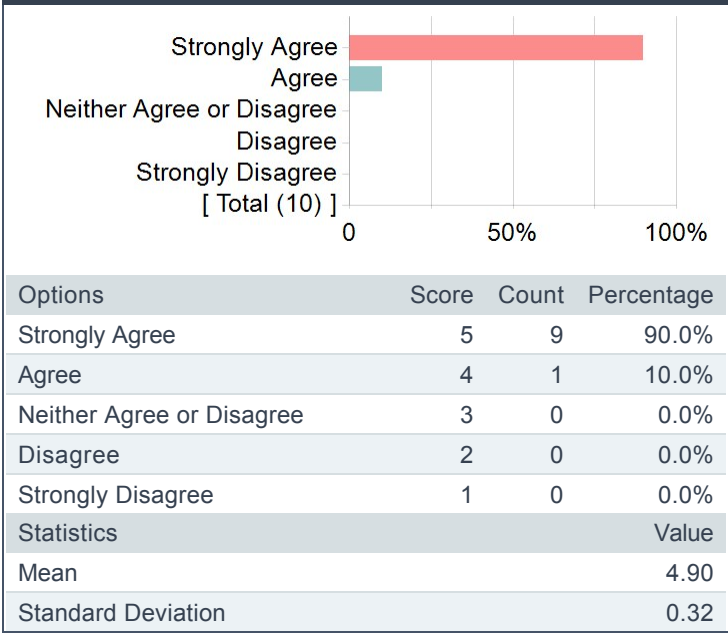

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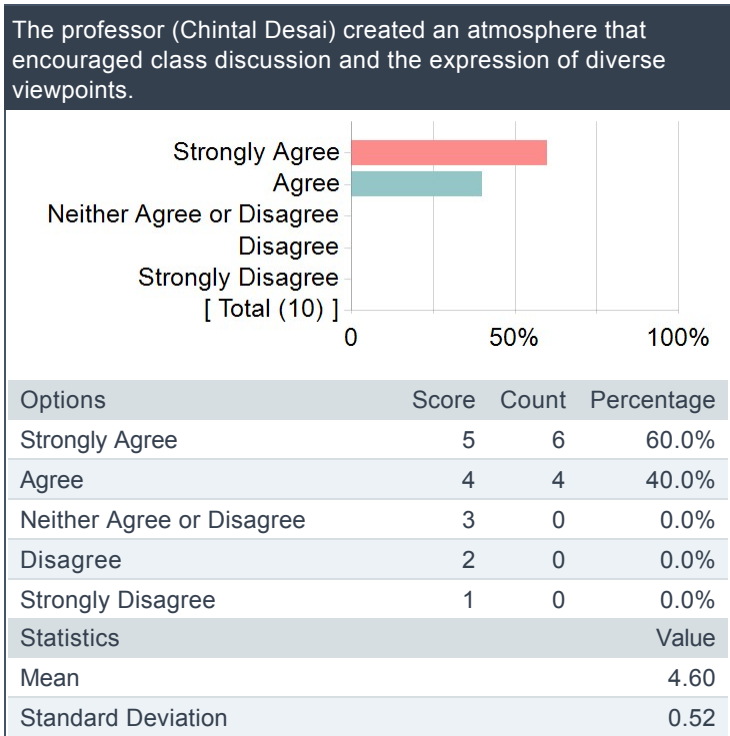


The professor (Chintal Desai) used class time effectively.

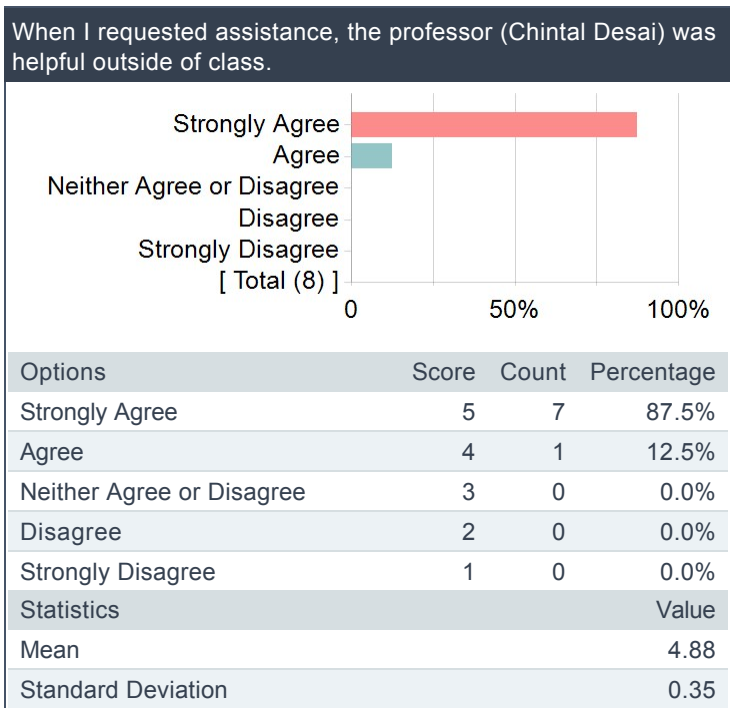

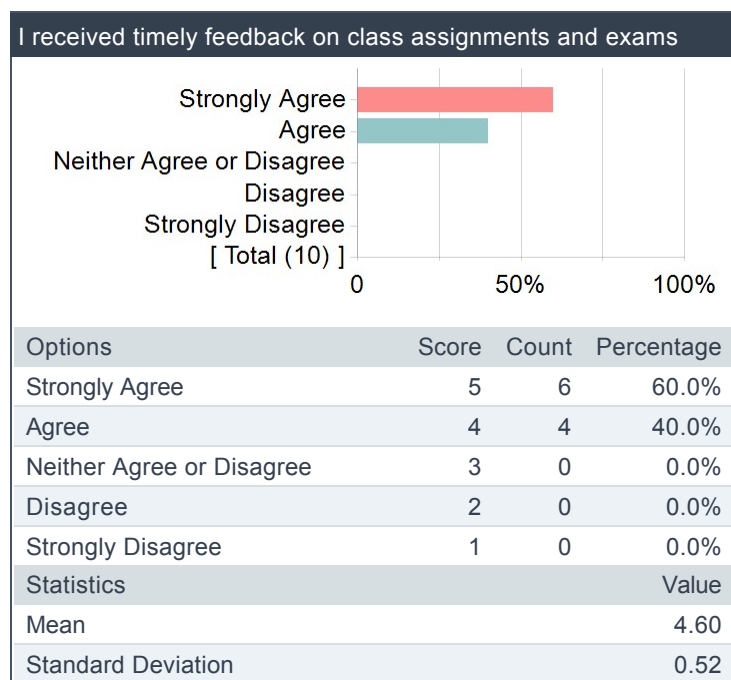

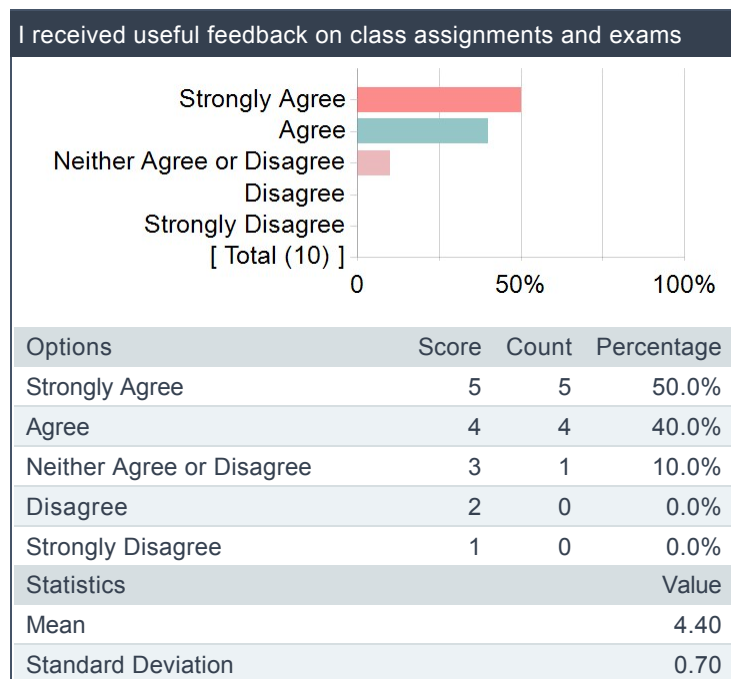

I received timely feedback on class assignments and exams

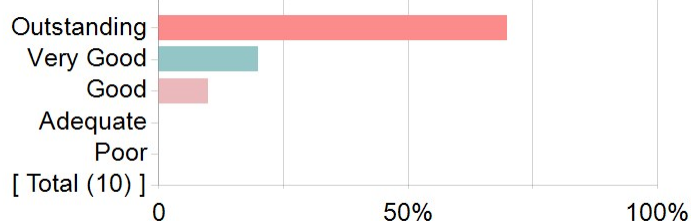


I received useful feedback on class assignments and exams
